



My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"He is not here. For he has been raised, just as he The angel of God announced to Mary Magdalene and her companion that Jesus was no longer in the tomb, and the world was now changed forever! The angel urges these women to announce Jesus' resurrection to his disciples. There is a further instruction: the disciples should travel to Galilee where they will see Jesus. The women went off quickly to share the "good news."

And this is not just good news, it is incredible news! Jesus has shown in resurrection that he is, indeed, the Son of God; Jesus is the Messiah; he is one with us---now and forever!

On the first Easter morning, the angel of God shares with the women news that will impact Christian believers forever. The Son of God is among us! In his death and resurrection, the Son has reclaimed humanity for the Father by his redemptive act which brings our sinfulness to the Throne of God.

Today, like Mary and her companion, we should be awed--struck by the magnitude of the angel's announcement: Jesus is risen. As it is for Mary and her companion, we should be awed by the incredible act of love that allowed Jesus to die for us so that in his resurrection, we can, forever, be one with him.. If we truly believe in the presence of Jesus in our lives, the Easter mystery becomes central to us. Jesus is, without doubt, the Son of God who is raised from the dead; and by this action, Jesus has redeemed the world!

After The Second Vatican Council, many Catholics, particularly here in the U.S. began to refer to themselves as "Easter" people. Second Vatican Council was very much in the news, and our Church was beginning to implement the Council's "new direction." There was a real sense that the People of God were not only committed to living their faith but anxious to begin participating more fully in the activity of the Church. Catholic really considered themselves to be "Easter people," that is, a people who were motivated in faith by Jesus: Jesus who had risen, Jesus who had taken our sinfulness to the Father, and Jesus who enlivened our hearts as we worshiped and prayed together.

Today we celebrate Easter, and we meditate on the great Easter miracle. Jesus has risen and remains with us now and forever! Today, before we begin our family celebrations, we might want to spend a few minutes in prayer and meditation, considering how we might remain an "Easter people" throughout the year.

Just like Mary and her companion, we must go forth from the tomb and remind the wider community that Jesus has, indeed, risen---and is now here, among us! By our lives, we need to witness the truth of Jesus, sharing his dynamic presence to all.
