

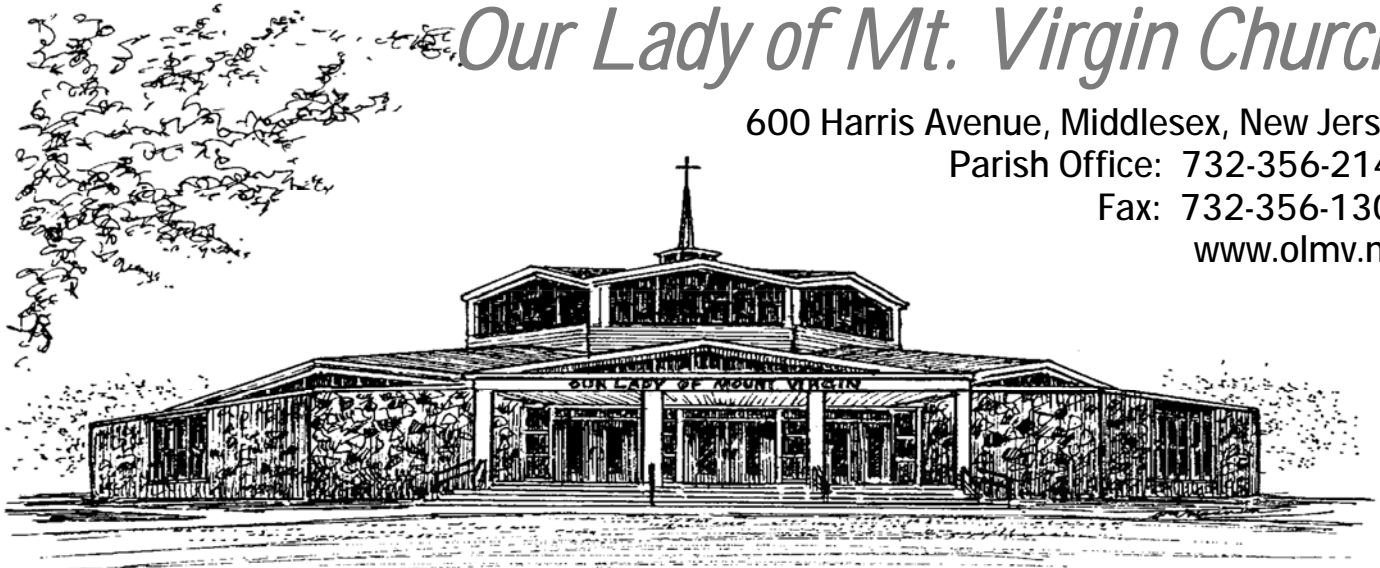

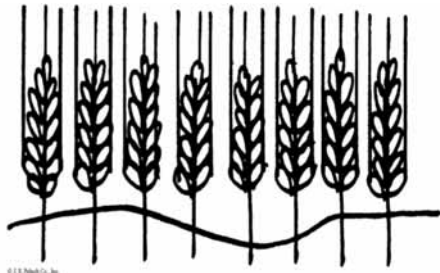

## **A NOTE FROM FATHER PAT** My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The end of May and the beginning of June is always an exciting time for us, Catholics in the Diocese of Metuchen, because we participate in the joyful celebrations of ordinations to the diaconate and to the holy priesthood. The current issue of **The Catholic Spirit** has beautiful and powerful stories on the recent ordination of two men to the priesthood. There are also stories about the ordination of three men to the “transitional” diaconate and of eighteen men to the “permanent” diaconate. Transitional deacons are men who are in formation to the priesthood and who serve as deacons, usually for one year, as part of their formation process. Permanent deacons are men who are “called forth” from the local community for “service” to the local church. Most, but not all, permanent deacons are married men with families. Among the permanent deacons ordained this year is our own Deacon Tom Sommero.

Each of these men, newly ordained by Bishop Bootkoski will minister in our diocese. We are blessed this year to have outstanding men who have listened to and answered God's call to service and who are now beginning their ministry in our diocese.

As Catholic people, when we speak about vocations, we seem to center on vocations to the priesthood, the diaconate and to religious life. Men might be called to religious life and serve as members of religious orders---sometimes as priests and sometimes as brothers. Women might be called by God to serve as “sisters,” that is, “women religious” who join a particular religious community. Religious (men and women) serve God's people as educators, medical professionals, social workers, in pastoral ministry and in many other ways while living lives of poverty, chastity and obedience.

Each of us, however, is called by God to “vocation.” As we mature to adulthood, God call most people to the vocation of married life. Marriage is a sacrament which confers the special grace that supports the couple in their love, strengthens their unity and sanctifies them on their journey to eternal life. The grace of the sacrament of Marriage encourages mutual fidelity and strengthens the bond of parents and children within the Christian home.

Certain people are called by God to the vocation of single life. They are “called” to live lives of exceptional holiness and service, and they are better able, as single persons, to devote themselves to the church and to God's people in different ministries.

Diocesan priests and religious priests as well as deacons are “ordained” and share in the Sacrament of Holy Orders with bishops. Religious brothers and sisters live in community and take vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. While they have and live a distinct vocation, they remain members of the laity, that is, all the baptized who are not “ordained” (bishops, priests and deacons).

So, each of us is called by God to live our “vocation” as we look to serve God and the church. Bishops, priests and deacons, men and women religious, married couples, persons who are single, young and old; we are all called to live and share our faith. The vocation we all share is to proclaim by word and work the Presence of Jesus Christ!

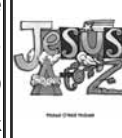
