





## **BROADWAY COMES TO OLMV**



**Godspell** is a musical by Stephen Schwartz which opened Off Broadway in May, 1971 and has been on tour with various theatrical companies around the world. One of its songs, **Day By Day**, reached # 13 on the Billboard pop single chart in the summer of 1972. The structure of the musical is a series of parables, mostly based on the Gospel of Matthew. The parables are interspersed with a variety of songs set to modern music and often based on traditional hymns. The Passion of Christ is treated briefly at the end of the production. A film version was released in 1973.

OLMV Parish is pleased to offer a production of **Godspell** on Friday, July 18 and Saturday, July 19 at 7:00pm each evening. The show will be held in the Church Hall which is air-conditioned. This show will be an adaptation by the "Outset" Players" led by Anthony Tumolo, a local thespian.

## **My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,**

Jesus invites us to himself in today's gospel: "Come to me all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." This is such a powerful invitation and one that gives us solace and hope, especially when life seems to overwhelm us. Jesus reminds us that he is present for us today and always, and when we enter into his presence, we give us comfort and sustenance.

These words of Jesus are often prayed as part of a wake service or funeral Mass, so we associate them with a person's passing from this life into eternity, and we think of them in very somber terms. But I think that these words are actually meant to be live-giving for us when our duties, responsibilities and challenges seem to be just too much to bear. It is exactly then that Jesus makes his loving and comforting presence known to us, and he reminds us that we are never alone as long as we remember to place our trust in him.

On Friday we celebrated the special American holiday: Independence Day. How quickly we have arrived at the time of vacation, relaxation and renewal of the spirit. It is a wonderful tradition that during the months of July and August we take time out of our busy schedules for vacations, family visits and reunions, neighborhood barbecues and those simple evenings when we can sit on the back porch and enjoy a cool breeze as we refresh our lives.

Everyone who is active here at Our Lady of Mount Virgin Parish notices the drop in weekly attendance at Mass during the summer months. Parishioners have homes by the shore or in the mountains and spend weekends there. Parishioners are away on vacations near and far. Hopefully many do attend Mass each weekend at local Catholic churches. It is an unfortunate reality that many parishioners take a vacation from Church during the spring and summer months, believing that church attendance follows the same cycle as the academic year of school or the religious education program.

There can be no doubt that we are diminished as a believing Catholic community when many of our brothers and sisters in faith are not present, and it is good to be reminded occasionally that we are called by Jesus to worship each week of the year, and that we pray best when we pray as members of a believing community---praying and worshipping together at Mass. Thank you to our parishioners who worship regularly at Mass each week! If you have gotten a little lax regarding regular worship, please make that effort to be here next weekend. Your brothers and sisters in faith want and need you to be worshipping with them. It is together that we make a great noise in praise of the Lord!

Even if you are not able to be here on the weekend, why not stop in for a few minutes during the week and say a short prayer. The church is open every day until 4:00pm and Jesus is always present, waiting for us to spend a few minutes with him. The **Catechism of the Catholic Church** defines prayer as a "vital and personal relationship with the living and true God." While any prayer in any place is acceptable to God, prayer in the midst of the community, especially at Mass is most acceptable, and prayer before Jesus present in the Tabernacle is powerfully received by God, our Father.

Have a great summer and don't forget to stop by here at OLMV to pray, worship and "rest in the Lord!"
